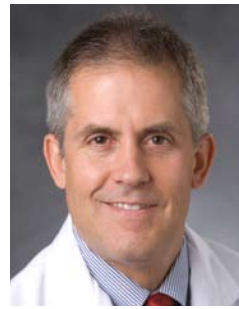
As one of the only surgeons in the area who provides
