Internship Program

Earn your first unit of CPE

- 100 hours supervised learning
- 300 hours clinical practice
- On-call responsibilities
- Tuition and Fees: \$450

Summer Intensive (Full Time)

- May – August*
- 40+ hours per week (11 weeks)

Extended/Parish Based Unit (Part Time)

- September – May*
- Class meets one day per week
- Fulfill clinical hours to suit your schedule
- Ability to fulfill some clinical hours in parish setting

Residency Program

- Begins each August*
- Earn 3 units of CPE during a calendar year
- Tuition: \$350 per unit
- Applicants must have completed at least one unit of CPE
- Benefits include: stipend, paid time off, health insurance and on-call meal vouchers

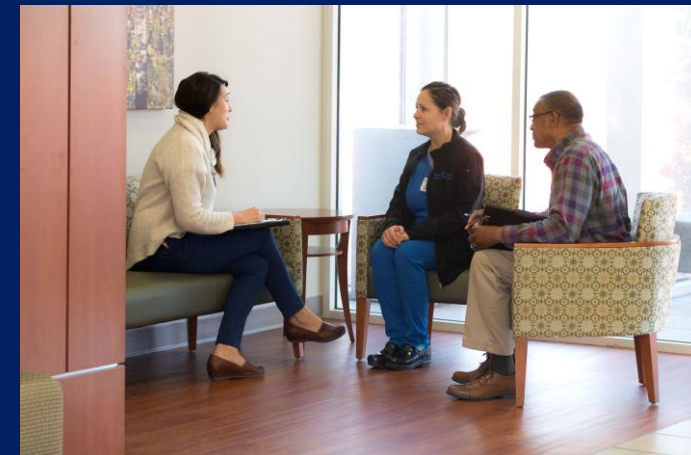

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is interfaith professional education for ministry. It brings theological students and ministers of all faiths into supervised encounters with persons in crisis.

Out of an intense involvement with persons in need and the feedback from peers and teachers, students develop a new awareness of themselves as persons and better understand the needs of those to whom they minister.

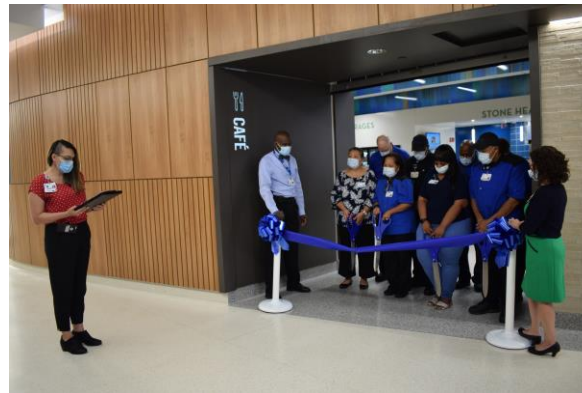
