We are excited to announce that **Duke Cancer Center North Durham** will reopen on June 15, 2020. Dr. Rosenberger and Samantha Verruto will begin seeing patients at this location on July 20, 2020.

Your Safety Is Important to Us

To protect those receiving care in our facilities, we are following recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and our infectious disease experts. The precautions include:

- Requiring all team members, providers, patients and visitors to wear masks.
- Screening every person for symptoms before entering our facilities.
- Rearranging our waiting rooms to encourage physical distancing.
- Performing enhanced cleaning of exam rooms between every patient and deep cleaning every night.
- Installing additional hand sanitizing stations.
- Keeping some respiratory clinics open so that patients with COVID-19 or flu-like symptoms can be seen in separate facilities.

Lab Work Will Be Done Before Your Appointment

Starting June 15, 2020, we will no longer do lab work in our clinic. If your appointment requires lab work, you will be asked to get your labs drawn prior to your appointment date. For your convenience, the Duke Health Lab and Leave locations are available with no appointment necessary. If these locations are inconvenient for you, please call 919-470-8600 to speak to a nurse for coordination of an alternative lab location.
